Further to Press Release of June 29, 2026, Consulate General of India, Dubai hereby wishes to inform that due to administrative reasons, the Embassy of India and the Consulate General of India will start providing Consular services (Passport, Visa, Attestation & Miscellaneous services) in limited manner from their own premises from tomorrow, July 2, 2026.

2. The details about availing the service at Embassy and the Consulate are as follows-

- ii. The services will be provided only on **walk-in** basis following the **first-come-first-serve** principle.
- iii. The walk-in timings will be from **9AM to 12:30 PM**.
- iv. To avail the services, all the applicants have to visit the Embassy or the Consulate in person along with **completely filled in application form** and requisite documents. The applications will be submitted at Embassy and the Consulate after payment of requisite fees.
- v. Only the applicant will be allowed inside the Embassy and Consulate premises to avoid crowding (except for the cases where presence of parents is mandatory for minor applicants).
- vi. The acceptance of fees will **only be in Cash** at present. Applicants are advised to keep the exact change according to the service desired. The applicants must also note that the service fee for passport related services has been updated and the new fee is effective since July 1, 2026. The updated fee schedule for Passport Services is attached at **Annexure-A** as given in below page.
