Surrender of Indian Passport/ Surrender Certificate

- 2. The dully filled in application is to be submitted at the outsourcing (BLS International) centre along with the prescribed fee (AED 95/- + AED 08/- ICWF).
- 3. The application is to be accompanied by
 - Original Indian Passport (while expired passports will be accepted, revoked, impounded and suspended passports will not be accepted for surrender)
 - ii. Two passport size photographs
 - iii. Proof of foreign nationality (Naturalization certificate or Registration certificate with date of acquisition of citizenship)
 - iv. Emirates ID with newly acquired nationality mentioned on it.
 - v. Proof of residence in the UAE (DEWA bill / tenancy contract / Bank account statement / Affidavit)

Note: If the document is in a **foreign language**, it should be translated into English by an authorized translator and then attested by the Consulate/ Foreign Ministry of which the applicant is a citizen.

- **4.** Signature on the application should be affixed before the staff at the designated places during submission.
- **5.** All applicants (except minors) could be called for personal interview at CGI, Dubai.
